ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2001
IN PURSUANCE OF ROAD TRAFFIC (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 2001
L. I. 1687 THE PUBLIC IS HEREBY INFORMED THAT WITH EFFECT
FROM 1ST DECEMBER, 2001, DVLA WOULD CHARGE NEW RATES IN
RESPECT OF ROAD TRAFFIC FEES AS FOLLOWS:

PROCEDURES AT DRIVER AND VEHICLE LICENSING AUTHORITY

PROCEDURES FOR ACQUIRING INTERNATIONAL DRIVING PERMIT

International driving Permit must possess a valid Ghanaian Driver's License holder granting him/her permission to drive in a foreign Country for a period of 1 year.

REQUIREMENTS

- i) A person applying for an international Driving Permit must possess a valid Ghanaian Drivers License
- ii) The applicant must also be cleared of bad driving record.
- iii) The applicant will also be required to produce two (2) coloured recent passport size photographs for the completion of Form 3A and the International Driving Permit license card.
- iv) A processing fee of 250,000 cedis is charged for the processing of documents

PROCEDURES FOR CONVERSION

To convert a motor vehicle from Private to Commercial and vice versa, the vehicle owner must:

- i) Submit an application for Conversion.
- ii) The application must contain the vehicle owner's Name, Chassis, and Engine Numbers of the vehicles as well as the make of the vehicle.
- iii) The vehicle must be brought to the premises of the Authority for inspection to ensure that the number plate and colour of the vehicle are appropriate for the conversion carried out.
- iv) A fee of 130,000 cedis is charged for the processing.
